PRIMARY SCHOOL FEES 2020

The Diocesan School Fee structure is made up of two components and is set by the Catholic Schools Office. Fees for **2020** are as follows:

Diocesan Tuition fees – are principally used to contribute to salary costs. The majority of salary costs are met by Commonwealth and State Government grants

Diocesan Schools Building Levy - This is to assist with the upgrading of school buildings and the construction of new schools in the Diocese of Broken Bay - \$970.00 per annum per family

ADDITIONAL FEES

St Patrick's School has two additional fees to those set by the Catholic Schools Office.

1. **School Based fee** - \$900.00 per child.

School Based Fees includes ~ Contribution towards Specialist Teachers, educational aids, craft, photocopying, class excursions and daily cleaning of the school. Whole School Excursions and Cultural Activities for 2020 include ~ St Patrick's Day Celebrations, Swimming Carnival and Athletics Carnival. N.B This does not include special events/functions e.g. Year 5 and 6 camps.

2. **P & F Maintenance Levy.**

The P&F Maintenance Levy of \$75.00 per family will be billed on your account. This levy assists in the cost involved in maintaining the school grounds.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

There are three choices of making payments and they are as follows:-

1. Whole year (ie one payment made in Term 1)
2. Three Instalments due at the beginning of Terms 1, 2 & 3
3. Time payment (by arrangement) – See Family Registration Form for options

BPay is the preferred option of CSO but payment options also available through the school office are ~

Cheque, Cash, EFTPOS (from Credit Card, Savings, Cheque account).
