Mercy Day

Mercy Day is the feast day of the Sisters of Mercy across the world. It is celebrated each year on **24th September**, the **Feast of Our Lady of Mercy**.

The Sisters of Mercy were founded by Catherine McAuley on December 12, 1831 in Dublin, Ireland. Sr. Catherine McAuley placed her community under the patronage of Our Lady of Mercy. Catherine sought to bring God's mercy to everyone in need.

Mercy Day is a special day of celebration and an opportunity for all Mercy Sisters and their associates, including our school started by the Sisters of Mercy, to celebrate and rejoice with Mary, the Mother of Mercy.

St. Patrick's was established by the Sisters of Mercy in 1958 and although the Sisters of Mercy withdrew from the parish at the end of 1987, the Mercy tradition of nurturing and educating has carried on in our school.

This week the children learnt a special Mercy Prayer that Pope Francis prays called (the five-finger) Prayer for Mercy.

The children also experienced a special assembly led by our Mercy Action Group, Mrs Susie Hopkins, Mrs Mary Connor and a guest. They learnt about the history and work of the Sisters of Mercy in our school. Tomorrow they will have the opportunity to share their learning they have done in class about the mission and values of the Sisters of Mercy with other classes. On Friday we will finish the week with a celebration in class and the children can wear mufti.

BOOK CHARACTER PARADE


