PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

Dear Parents and Carers, Girls and Boys,

Each afternoon this week we reflected on the Holy Week story leading into the celebration of Easter this Sunday. Beginning with our Kindergarten students retelling the events of Palm Sunday and Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem and then Stage 1 and 3 presenting the events of Holy Thursday, encompassing Jesus' washing the disciples' feet, the last supper and crucifixion.

But the story doesn't end there: our Stage 2 students remind us of Jesus' resurrection on Easter Sunday and how that changed everything. His empty tomb, his appearance to his disciples by the lake, on the road to Emmaus and to Thomas is the basis of our Christian story and gives us all hope.

Parent/Teacher Interviews

Parent/Teacher Interviews are scheduled for Week 2 of Term 2 (May 1st-4th) with an evening session scheduled for Wednesday 3rd May. The interviews provide parents with an opportunity to meet their child's teacher and discuss their progress and set goals for the year ahead. Parents can now book an interview time with the child/ren's teacher via Compass. Parents can attend a face-to-face interview at school or attend via Zoom. School Uniform

I am thankful for the overwhelming support by our parent community to send their child/ren each day dressed in their correct school uniform. In the last few weeks, we have had only a handful of students needing reminders about wearing the correct shoes or refraining from wearing additional items that are not part of the school uniform. A reminder to parents that the beginning of next term, we will have a 'phase in' period towards Winter uniform. Students may wear either full Summer or full Winter uniform (but not a combination) for the first four weeks of Term 2. Students should be in full Winter uniform by Monday 15th May. Covid-19 Reminder

Although we haven't had any further reported cases of Covid-19 I ask that parents continue to be vigilant of symptoms and adhere to the requirements listed below. To support families the school is sending home more RAT kits this week to be used as required.

- Students and staff should continue to stay home when sick. Students, staff and visitors should only attend school when they are symptom free. We strongly encourage all students, staff and visitors to follow the guidance issued by NSW Health External. We will continue to send home students or staff displaying symptoms.
- Positive COVID-19 cases should be reported to the school if they have attended school recently.
- NSW Health and the Department of Education encourage all students and staff who test positive to COVID-19 to record the positive rapid antigen test (RAT) through the Service NSW websiteExternal link or Service NSW appExternal link. Voluntary registration of your positive RAT with Service NSW can help you access health support and antiviral medicinesExternal link if you are eligible.
- Parents and carers are asked to select the name of the school or early childhood centre when registering a positive RAT via Service NSW.



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- All families will receive additional RAT test kits. Positive RAT or PCR test results for staff and students should be reported to the school.
- Anyone who believes they have been exposed to COVID-19 is strongly recommended to monitor for symptoms and test if they have any concerns, as well as wear a mask.
- I thank parents in advance for supporting these measures which keep our school community safe.
