#### **Enrolments 2024**

In the last 2 weeks I have had great interest with new families for both Kinder 2024 and in other grades meeting with me, touring the school and applying for enrolment. These new families often remark that they get a feeling about the school that is welcoming, friendly and inviting.

Just this week, one of our Uniform Shop volunteers, Michelle, supported a new enrolment through her cultural background while finding uniform items and gave a great welcome communicating in their common language. The student and family having arrived in Australia only last week in that moment felt that friendly, welcoming invitation to be part of our school community. Afterwards I was impressed by some of our Stage 3 students who asked if the new student could be in their class.

We continue to gear up for our Kinder 2024 Transition sessions scheduled for 3 consecutive weeks in November. I remind current parents who have yet to enrol their school aged children to start Kinder in 2024 to contact the school office to enrol now.
