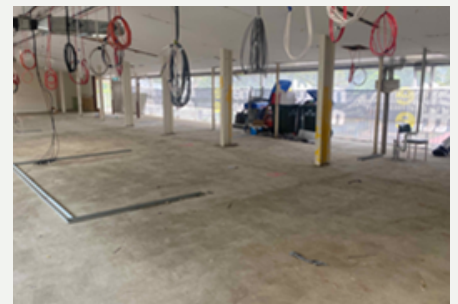


## PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

Dear Parents and Carers, Girls and Boys,

I am excited to announce that the first stage of the school refurbishment is scheduled to be completed by the end of Term 1. Our Stage 3 classes should begin Term 2 in new classrooms with new furniture set to arrive and placed into these rooms during the holidays.

The next stage of the refurbishment will involve the Kindergarten classrooms, the staffroom and the front office. The relocation of these spaces will also occur in the holiday break. Kindergarten will move upstairs and utilise the new library during this stage of the refurbishment. The staffroom will relocate to the school hall and the school office will move to a ground level classroom in Block C. Further information will be provided later in the term regarding any adjustments that will be made while Stage 2 of the refurbishment is being completed.
