From the Principal

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are fast approaching the end of the school year and there is still much to do and celebrate. This week we have the Leadership Assembly with the announcement of new captains for 2025.

Week 8, the whole school celebrates the Christmas story at our Christmas Concert. We have Step-up for students in Kinder to Year 5 as they find out their classes and teachers for 2025.

Week 9 we celebrate another wonderful year of learning, fun and community at our End of School Mass, our Year 6 students enjoy their celebration day at Moving Bodies while Year 3-5 students participate in the Annual School Swimming Carnival and the K-2 students have their Water Fun Day.

In Week 10 we celebrate and farewell our leaving students with the Guard of Honour and we acknowledge and thank our Year 6 students as we celebrate their graduation.

Year 5 Leadership Opportunities

Our entire Year 5 group demonstrated outstanding leadership in the past few weeks as they supported the Kinder 2025 Transition Sessions. It has been exciting for our Year 5 students to meet their buddies for next year and spend time together. This is a great way for our new students to be settled into the school and reduce any anxieties. I am so encouraged by our Year 5 groups efforts and proud of the way they have stepped-up to lead this initiative.

In the past few weeks, nominated Year 5 students also put themselves forward to be selected as School Captains and Colour House Captains for 2025. It is very encouraging to have so many students nominating for a leadership position. Although there are only 10 badged leadership positions available, I am sure I will be able to call on any student to assist and support wherever needed.

All selected leaders will be announced at our Leadership Assembly on Friday this week from approximately 2:00pm. We will also acknowledge and thank our current school leaders for the excellent way they have led the school this year.

Semester 2 School Reports

The class teachers are busily writing the Semester 2 Reports which will be available through your COMPASS App later in the term. This semester report will provide information on your child's achievement in the various curriculum areas and their learning dispositions for Term 3 and Term 4. Parents are encouraged to contact the office if you would like to discuss the report with your child's teacher.

Class Arrangements for 2025

This week I communicated some changes in class arrangements for 2025. As Catholic Schools Broken Bay reduced the staffing allocation in line with our current enrolments we will have the following class groups:

Early Stage 1- 2 Kindergarten classes

Stage 1- Year 1, Year 1/2 and Year 2 classes.

Stage 2- Year 3 and Year 4 classes

Stage 3- Year 5 and Year 6 classes

Next year's arrangement of single classes for Years 3-6 has come about due to the size of the groups in each grade which does not warrant an additional class group.

I understand that parents may be concerned with the new arrangements. CSBB is providing additional classroom support for our school that the school will utilize to support learning in these classrooms especially during the morning at peak learning times.

Staffing for 2025

During our transition sessions, we seek to inform parents and new Kindergarten students about their teachers and class placements. Last week, we were delighted to announce the Kindergarten class teachers for 2025 are Mrs. Kylie Lloyd-Jones, Mrs. Loretta Rapa and Mrs. Doris Russell.

In the same way, we also seek to inform all the children who their class and teacher arrangements are for next year in the coming weeks. Doing this often reduces any worries the children and sometimes parents have leading up to the start of school.

However, with the current reduction in staffing allocation the school is still in the process of finalising staffing for 2025. In the coming weeks we will hold a Step-up Day where the children will find out who their teacher and classmates will be for next year.

Around this time of the year, it is not unusual to have some families relocate to other areas due to a change of circumstances. **We ask parents to contact the school via email or phone call if your circumstances have changed and you will be leaving the school at the end of the year.**

Christmas Concert

We are excited about the upcoming Christmas Concert scheduled for next week on the evening of Friday 6th December. We are looking forward to a fun evening for all families as we come together to celebrate.

We will begin the evening with a sausage sizzle followed by some favourite Christmas carols led by our school band prepared by Mrs Jacobson, the church choir with Mrs Pat Smith and then school choir led by Mrs Pugsley. Following this our guest performer, Drew Lane, will facilitate the remainder of the concert with the live performance of items prepared during the day.

The concert will take place in the main assembly area (weather permitting). The children will sit in their class groups. Parents are encouraged to bring along a picnic rug or fold-up chairs to sit on to watch the concert. As we have done previously, there will be a section towards the front for picnic rugs with chairs further back to allow a good view for all attending.

2 pens will move from the last set to the middle to make 5 in each.


Hudson won a bag of marbles in the lucky dip at the show.
