Online Safety

Last Wednesday evening, Mrs Schyvens and I presented a Cyber Safety Talk to parents at the P&F Meeting. The purpose was to support families in navigating the online challenges experienced from time to time. We continue to encourage you to monitor your child's online activity, including their participation in group chats, messaging apps, and games such as Roblox or similar platforms. Regularly checking their messages and having open conversations about respectful online behaviour can make a big difference.



















On the weekend of 15th and 16th November, the NSW talent enrichment weekend will be held for primary students at
