# PRINCIPAL'S UPDATE

#### **Dear Parents and Carers.**

This week's Science Day was a resounding success, with students diving into a full day of hands-on experiments, discovery, and scientific wonder! From chemical reactions to gravity-defying challenges, our classrooms and playgrounds were transformed into busy hubs of exploration.

The highlight of the day was the Science Challenge Relay, held in the afternoon, where over 100 parents joined us to cheer and compete alongside students and teachers. The energy was electric as teams of students, teachers, and parents faced off in a fun and friendly competition. There was lots of laughter, learning, and a touch of rivalry which made for an unforgettable experience.

A huge thank you to our wonderful Librarian, Mrs Wickham, for organising the event and to the teachers, students and parents who participated, supported, and helped make the day so special. Science Day not only celebrated learning-it brought our school community together in the most inspiring way.

#### **Attendance Concerns**

Last week I communicated to all parents about my concerns regarding our schools slipping attendance rate. All schools have a general target of 95% or above attendance rate. We systematically review attendance data for all students and began the year with a Term 1 school average of 95.2% attendance. However, in Term 2 our school attendance average slipped to 90.5%. I understand that some absences are unavoidable due to illness or family circumstances, however it is important for parents to be aware when absences accumulate to a level that creates negative impacts. Currently we have concerns regarding the attendance pattern of some students and I am obliged to communicate directly with some families outlining these concerns. I thank all families in advance for your continued support with this matter.

#### **School Uniform**

At the beginning of Term 4 all students will need to wear their full summer uniform. Please label items like school hats, jackets and jumpers with the children's name. If you are missing items, please check the lost property area on the verandah outside the kindergarten classrooms.
