#### Key Dates for Year 1-6 in 2026

The first day back at school in 2026 for all children in Year 1-6 is Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> January.

#### **Key Dates for Kindergarten in 2026**

Kindergarten will complete the Kindergarten Screener on Thursday 29th. The first day of school for Kindergarten is Friday 30th January.

Kindergarten students will commence full day school attendance with a slightly earlier pick-up from 2:40pm to support the establishment of the pick-up routine. This will continue for the following week with the later pick-up time of 2:55pm with all students beginning in Week 3.

#### **School Uniform**

A reminder to parents to please check the requirements for school uniform before making purchases during the Christmas break. The error sometimes made is purchasing school shoes that are not fully black or are a totally different colour. I ask parents to respect the agreed uniform code and purchase only items that align with our uniform policy. I have provided a link for your convenience- School Uniform

## e-bike Safety Information

The NSW Government have published an important update regarding e-bikes in the lead up to Christmas.

Schools may wish to share this via their families via regular communication channels.

"With around 600,000 households now owning an e-bike, and many more expected to buy one this Christmas, parents are being urged to check that any new device is safe, compliant and appropriate for young riders.

Parents buying an e-bike this Christmas are encouraged to look for:

- 1. A clear EN 15194 sticker or certification
- 2. A motor output of no more than 250 watts
- 3. A reputable brand with proper safety documentation
- 4. A model that has not been modified, "chipped," or had its speed limiter removed

The Government is also urging parents to talk to their kids about responsible riding: wearing a helmet, not carrying passengers, sticking to bike paths and roads where permitted, and never modifying a device to go faster."
